## **Meet Keven Withers** Student at The Academy, providing Ministry Leadership at the First Presbyterian Church in Osakis

It was 21 years ago when a pastor first mentioned to Keven Withers of Osakis that he thought Keven would make a great pastor. It was not the right time in Keven's life, but he never forgot those words, and a seed was planted. Time passed, and eventually Pastor Randy Knuth came to serve the Osakis church. Pastor Randy also identified Keven as someone with pastoral gifts and began working with Keven to give him experience in the pulpit and in worship leadership. Pastor Randy would write a sermon that Keven would then read on occasion. As time passed, Pastor Randy helped Keven develop the entire worship service. Keven was gaining experience, and with it came a growing sense of call.

When Pastor Randy moved away from Osakis, Pastor Paul Snyder began serving as Keven's mentor. With Pastor Paul as a mentor, Keven would also have opportunity to do funerals and graveside services and even learn to moderate the Session. His confidence and sense of call would continue to grow. With encouragement from Pastor Paul, Keven decided that it was time to act. He would take classes through The Academy and begin preparing to seek a call and serve officially as a Commissioned Ruling Elder. Pastor Paul would help Keven join two groups that would offer support. One group is of pastors who study the scripture text together every week to help in the development of sermons. The other group is of new pastors supporting each other. In addition, Keven has joined the Ministerial Association in his town and will be attending our Ministry Leaders' Retreat.

Keven says that he has received financial support from his home church in Osakis, from the Presbytery and scholarships from the Synod and The Academy that have been helpful. This support has also helped to encourage Keven in developing his sense of call. He has now taken two classes at the Academy, during the week of Synod school, and is busily finishing up homework assignments for both. He suggests that it might be better to start with one class, but as much work as it is, he is nevertheless excited to have begun this process.

We celebrate the Osakis Church for being a church that has called a member into ministry, the pastors who helped Keven discover and develop his sense of call, the support he receives from so many, and Keven Withers, a new Commissioned Ruling Elder in the making!
