Greetings.

I hope everyone survived the cold winter this year. According to the calendar spring is here. Yesterday when I went for an early morning walk, I could see a couple of Robins singing and then this morning I saw one in the neighbor's yard, a sure sign of spring. Before we know it, the trees will start budding and spring flowers will start poking up out of the ground as we experience new life once again.

On Ash Wednesday we enjoyed a small meal and worshiped together with imposition of ashes and communion to begin our Lenten journey. We continue to worship each Sunday morning following Jesus to the Cross. We have been worshiping in the Parlor since Epiphany and will soon move back to the Sanctuary for Palm Sunday and Holy Week, which will include a Maundy Thursday Service with communion, and share the story of Jesus' crucifixion.
